Toronto Police Department Incident Report [Canadian Coast Guard Preliminary Report]

RE: – Note found in Water Cooler Bottle, Dated April 20, 1964

- One **Kitty Finch** loses Baby
- One **Forrest Bronson** loses Delores
- The Inhabitants of one SACK Island may lose their lives

[Contents of the unsigned note follow:]

Help us!!! Our plane, en route to Mexico, has crashed on what we are calling SACK Island, and things are becoming desperate.

Company CEO **Dougie 'Bottom Line' Burns** has somehow left the island in a 'Huff' (reportedly a one-seater sea plane) and has promised to blow up the island. **Detective Benvolio Cain** is trying to rally the staff of ADHD to form a plan of escape but he is making slow headway.
